

## Step 1: Revise accepted papers for final submission

1. Authors of accepted papers will prepare a final version of their papers and will submit it using the [EDAS](#) online submission system. The version of the final manuscript will be substantially the same as the submitted full paper but will take into account reviewers' comments. The final paper must be completed and submitted on or before the "Final Submission and Author Registration" deadline.
2. If your paper is accepted by the review process for presentation and publication at ICTCS 2025, you should prepare your final manuscript for submission. This will be substantially the same as the submitted paper but must consider reviewers' comments. The ICTCS 2025 Technical Program Committee reserves the right to reject a final manuscript if the reviewers' comments are not adequately addressed.
3. **The final manuscripts must not contain page number and the first page must not contain any header or footer.** Final manuscripts not conforming with the required format will not appear in the proceedings.
4. The final version of an accepted paper will appear in the conference proceedings provided that at least one of the authors registers. This must be carried out on or before the "Final Submission and Registration" deadline

The final version of your accepted paper will appear in the conference proceedings provided that at least one of the authors register.
